Under its aegis Ajmal Foundation Hojai has initiated, planned and observed a series of events to celebrate glorious 75 years of India's Independence from 12th to 15th August 2022 across the length and breadth of its various institutions located in different areas of Assam.



Activities Organised

1. Quiz Competition on 12th of August 2022
2. Painting Competition on 13th August 2022
3. Lighting and decoration of the college campuses including display of Flags and tricolour from 13th to 15th August 2022
4. Display and flying of Air Balloons from 13th to 15th August 2022
5. Car and Bike Rally on 14th August 2022
6. Main celebration with various cultural events on 15th August 2022.







Brief Report

The preparation for grand celebration of India's Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav started rolling in from the Week 1 of August 2022. Under the guidance of Dr. Khasrul Islam, Director Ajmal Foundation and Dr. MRH Azad, General Manager, Ajmal Foundation a ten-member steering committee was formed and directed to planned out the entire event starting from 12th August 2022 to 15th August 2022. Accordingly, the steering committee planned all the event details keeping in align with the true spirit of freedom and designed the full course of celebration. All the events were planned in such a manner so that it provided equal opportunities to all the students, teachers, staff and also family members to participate and enjoy the real spirit of Independence and freedom. The steering committee ensured meeting every alternate day till 14th Aug 2022 to ensure smooth and error free celebration and observation of Indian Independence Day.

About 12th August 2022

On 12th August 2022 Ajmal Foundation in collaboration with the Office of the Circle Officer, Hojai organised a quiz competition among the students of Ajmal Group of Institutions. Altogether 8 teams from different institution under Ajmal Group participated. The quiz was structured by Ajmal IAS Academy. Nazir Ajmal Memorial College of Education bagged the first prize, followed by Maryam Ajmal Women's College of Science and Technology in 2nd position and Maryam Ajmal Senior Secondary School of Arts in 3rd position. Altogether 5 rounds were organised in the said competition.

About 13th August 2022:

13th August marked the real beginning of the three-day long celebration of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. The biggest challenge of the day was to fly and display the air balloon at three prime locations in Ajmal Foundation Head Office, Ajmal Law College and Maryam Ajmal Women's College of Science and Technology. The work for gas filling of the procured balloons started from the evening of 11th August 2022 as the display of these air balloons required a gestation time of minimum 24 hours. But with dedicated efforts of our team members the balloons got ready on time and it was displayed in the mentioned location on 13th August 2022.

This was followed by decoration and lighting of the Ajmal institutions. A painting competition on the same theme was also organised among all the students of Ajmal Group of Institutions. In the evening hours after the dusk a three-member team from Ajmal Foundation Head Office visited every institution and observed both the internal as well as external decorations of the schools and colleges of Ajmal Group.

About 14th August 2022:

14th August 2022 is the most awaited day for every member of Ajmal Foundation Head office as well as for the faculties and staff of Ajmal Group of Institutions. A car and bike rally were organised which was also attended and flag off by Honourable Member of Parliament as well as Managing Trustee of Ajmal CSR Maulana Badruddin Ajmal Sahab. The rally started from the campus of Maryam Ajmal Women's College of Science and Technology and proceeded towards Doboka Town and ended via Jurapukhuri in College Road Hojai. Altogether more than 120+ bikes, 37 cars, 8 buses, 40 e-rickshaws have participated in the rally.

In this rally a tri colour of 1km was also displayed and marched along with by the students of Ajmal Super40 and Ajmal Senior Secondary School from Hojai Police Point to Ajmal Law College.

About 15th August 2022:

Here comes the final day of the celebration. On 15th August 2022 the day started with uniform flag hoisting ceremony in all schools and colleges located in Hojai including the head office at 6:00 am. Dr. Khasrul Islam hoisted the flag in the office premises of Ajmal Foundation. This was followed by a centralised celebration in the Hostel Campus Building of Maryam Ajmal Women’s College of Science and Technology. The Chief Guest on the occasion was Prof. (Dr.) Amalendu Chakraborty, Vice Chancellor, Rabindranath Tagore University, Hojai. The program was also graced by Honourable Member of Parliament as well as Managing Trustee of Ajmal CSR Maulana Badruddin Ajmal Sahab. The prime attraction of the program was hoisting of the 75 Indian Flags commemorating 75 years of Indian Independence.

Besides the program was also attended by a host of other prominent dignitaries and guest from different walks of Hojai’s social and cultural arena. The chief guest in his speech laid emphasis on what it really meant to be free and how freedom should be cherished and celebrated in our day-to-day life. He also laid importance on the value of culture, society, beliefs and traditions and how assimilation of all these spearheaded Indian freedoms struggle the fruits of which we are reaping now. 1. All existing COVID-19 protocols should strictly be followed.
2. Maintenance of Law & Order.
3. Utterance of any objectionable slogans, displaying of festoons, play cards criticizing others/any political/religious group are strictly prohibited. Organizer will take all necessary steps to keep the noise within permissible limits.
4. **Microphone should be used in moderate sound during the programme. All programmes must be held between 09:30 AM to 11:30 AM.** Existing curfew norms will strictly be adhered to.
5. Organizer will inform the nearest police station immediately, if any untoward situation arises.
6. Organizer must maintain peace and tranquility before, during and after the programme and sufficient volunteers must be used for maintenance of peace and discipline during the programme.
7. Organiser should ensure that there should not be any traffic congestion.
8. The organizer shall invariably seek the assistance of the police on duty for dealing with persons disturbing or otherwise attempting to create disorder. Organisers themselves shall not take action against such person. They will inform the nearest Police Station immediately if such situation arises.
9. The organizer shall ensure for providing adequate personal safety materials like masks, hand gloves, provision for sanitizer and hand wishing facilities to the participants.
10. The organizer shall ensure that social distancing norms are strictly followed at the programme. All kinds of mass gathering at the venue is strictly prohibited.
11. Emergency Support and Rehabilitation
 → Doing his bit by providing relief for the marginalised section of the society, Ajmal Foundation has provided low-cost houses or house construction materials to 7617 families, and constructed 13546 tube wells, ring wells and wells in different arid regions of the many states of the country. Distributed livelihood supports to around 7849 families, provided one-time livelihood support to widows, offered marriage aid and medical aid, etc. Ajmal Foundation made a benchmark among all the communities irrespective of caste, colour, creed and religion for its services during emergency relief. The trust also installed 387 solar panels and nearly 29-48 toilet blocks in various educational institutions. A total of around 60 lacs people have benefited so far with the trust.

habit of taking various tobacco items, food habits and ignorance about health, etc. Every year we conduct a routine awareness program in collaboration with various stakeholders and local administration, CRMs, etc. we have a tie-up with TATA Medical Center, Kolkata for cancer patients and so far we had sent more than 431 patients for treatment and most of them were cured. Every year, the trust conducts surveys to support the physically challenged and accordingly awareness programs are arranged to help them get their disability card, and distribute disability aids to these beneficiaries in collaboration with ALMCO and other local stakeholders. The Foundation also provides assistance depending on the availability of funds to the patients," states M Badruddin Ajmal.

Ajmal Foundation is a registered public charitable trust, established in the year 2005 at Hojai, Assam, India. Since then, the organisation has been working in the fields of modern education, skill development and employment generation, women empowerment, poverty alleviation, relief and rehabilitation, and environmental awareness and health aid programmes. The Foundation responds to socio-economic development in India through the implementation of various community-based integrated projects targeting the youth, women, elderly people, adults, children and the differently abled. In doing so, time-bound implementation, efficient delivery of the assigned projects and full transparency have always remained a top priority of the organisation," shares M Badruddin Ajmal. Ajmal Foundation is a Pan India organisation primarily focusing on the North Eastern States to contribute to nation building process to make India a strong, resilient and leading Country in the world.

Vision and Mission
 → The foundation's mission is to uplift the underprivileged to their optimum level through education, skill development and livelihood promotion by using modern technology and their mission is to establish institutions for imparting quality education, provide skill training to

unemployed youths for a sustainable livelihood and promotion of awareness campaign in regards to water, healthcare, environment and sanitation, etc.

 → With the motto — Ajmal for Education and Education for All — the foundation has been promoting modern and quality education in the remote and backward areas to support poor and economically weak students in the form of providing scholarships for higher education, medical, engineering, management and other professional courses. Moreover, the foundation has been running 32+ educational institutions all across Assam. The Foundation established AJMAL SUPER-40 in 2016 to guide and care for students for medical and engineering entrance examinations. The trust also conducts various national and international level workshops,

seminars and conferences to keep the teachers updated and to improve the level of their teaching standards. The trust also runs a distance education center under KKHISOL, Assam Sahitya Sabha and MFLS, etc. The foundation also established computer education in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and NIELIT to promote digital literacy," says Sirajuddin Ajmal, Managing Trustee.

Providing Health Aids
 → Each day almost 8-10 people visit our office for medical assistance. In most cases, the patients are either hospitalised or in bad condition as a result of an accident, injury or requiring immediate surgery and further treatment advised by a doctor, etc. These patients have no funds for treatment. The foundation arranges funds for them from many sources and even though its resources are limited, it has been able to help the people to mitigate their suffering. The number of cancer patients is increasing day by day especially due to the traditional

Environmental Promotion
 → Environmental awareness, promotion and protection have been one of the prime objectives of the trust, so, every year the foundation conducts different activities such as essay writing, various competitions, awareness programs, lecture sessions, etc. In collaboration with various stakeholders, community people and the local administration for a safe environment. Every year World Environment Day is observed by planting trees to restore the ecosystem. Ajmal Foundation raised the voice on AIDS awareness in Hojai where more than 1000 people from different backgrounds including students, teachers, policymakers, local leaders, social activists, lawmakers, physicians, etc. joined the campaign. The foundation initiated a mass awareness campaign against tobacco use in different districts of Assam for the noble cause of saving young lives and their income and to stop anti-social and evil activities by observing 'No Tobacco Day' in Hojai in collaboration with the district administration.
